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## Do Before Class

Please precut Block Background and the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips needed for the Split blades. Sew strips together in pairs and press seams open. (We will cut blades in class.)

## Cutting Directions

Strips are cut across the width of the fabric. Strips should be a minimum of 40 " long
